These individuals may have been recognized for contributing to school safety and security at their school and/or community. Candidates may be interested in a wide range of subjects and are willing to take meaningful risks. They prioritize results over appearances and value integrity and honesty. Character, service and leadership are the primary selection criteria for the South Florida FOSSUSA Scholarship program.

Their approach to improving safety is rooted in improving communication, awareness and participating in programs that inspire positive behavior, cooperative relationships and a safer school environment.

Scholarship Purpose

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance to students who have chosen to further their education and are considering a career in Public Safety.

Eligibility

- Students from within the State of Florida that are currently enrolled in their graduating year and will be enrolled full-time in a degree or diploma program at an accredited university or college in the fall academic term. The degree must be within the Public Safety field of study.
- A minimum of 2.5 GPA (Attach Transcript or letter from School)
- Has not received a full scholarship
- Outstanding in the area of citizenship and community service
